**Cobb & Douglas Public Health  
Resident Referral Options for Swine Flu (H1N1 Flu)  
Screening, Diagnosis & Treatment**

- 1) A Cobb or Douglas resident, who is an existing patient of Dr. Mandock, Dr. Joseph or Dr. Alvarez with Cobb & Douglas Public Health may be scheduled or worked into the daily schedule and seen at the Marietta Public Health Center or the Smyrna Public Health Center.
- 2) A Cobb or Douglas resident, who is under age 21, has no primary care doctor and has Medicaid insurance, may be scheduled or worked into the daily schedule and seen at the Marietta Public Health Center or the Smyrna Public Health Center by Dr. Mandock or Dr. Joseph. Normal eligibility screening guidelines apply and Medicaid primary care fees will be billed.
- 3) A Cobb or Douglas resident, who is under age 18, has no primary care doctor and has no insurance, may be scheduled or worked into the daily schedule and seen at the Marietta Public Health Center or the Smyrna Public Health Center by Dr. Mandock or Dr. Joseph. Normal eligibility screening guidelines apply and normal primary care self-pay fees apply.
- 4) A Cobb or Douglas resident, who has a primary care provider, should contact that provider for Swine Flu (H1N1 Flu) Screening, Diagnosis & Treatment.
- 5) A Cobb or Douglas resident, who does not have a primary care physician and who does not meet any of the above descriptions, may be referred to the following locations (Normal processes will apply):
